**Thammasat University Regulation, re:
The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University
Scholarships for Graduate Students (No. 2), B.E. 2567**

Where it is deemed appropriate to amend the Thammasat University Regulation, re: The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students.

By virtue of Section 23 (2) and (4) of the Thammasat University Act, B.E. 2558, and by the resolution of the University Council from the 2/2567 Meeting, which took place on February 27th, 2024, it has been agreed to amend the aforementioned regulation, as follows.

Article 1 – This Regulation is called “*Thammasat University Regulation, re: The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students (No. 2), B.E. 2567*”

Article 2 – This Regulation shall come into force from the day after the announcement date onwards.

Article 3 – The provision described under Article 8 of the Thammasat University Regulation, re: The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students, B.E. 2564, will be repealed and the following provision will be used instead.

“Article 8 – The Management Committee of Scholarships for Graduate Students shall consist of the following members.

(1) The Rector shall serve as the Chairman of the Committee.

(2) The Vice Rector for Research Administration shall serve as the Vice Chairman of the Board

(3) The Vice Rector for Planning shall serve as a director.

(4) The Vice Rector for Academic Affairs shall serve as a director.

(5) The Vice Rector for Finance shall serve as a director.

(6) The Assistant to the Rector for Research Administration shall serve as a director.

(7) The President of the Faculty Senate shall serve as a director.

(8) The Directors of the Academic Service Division, Treasury Division, and Planning Division shall serve as directors.

(9) Experts in the fields of Social Sciences, Humanities, Science and Technology, and Health Sciences, at most 1 expert from each field, shall be appointed by the Rector as directors.

(10) The Director of the Research Administration Division shall serve as a director and secretary of the Committee

The Director of the Research Administration Division may appoint at most 2 other workers of the Research Administration Division as assistant secretaries.

Members of the Committee under Item (9) shall have a term of office of 2 years, and they can be reappointed.

If there is no Assistant to the Rector for Research Administration then the Management Committee of Scholarships for Graduate Students shall consist of available members.”

Article 4 – The provision described under Article 9 of the Thammasat University Regulation, re: The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students, B.E. 2564, will be repealed and the following provision will be used instead.

“Article 9 – The Committee shall have the authority and duty to manage the Scholarship as per objectives described under Article 5, as follows.

(1) Consider and determine the guidelines and operational plans of the Scholarship while taking into account the university’s development goals.

(2) Consider and determine criteria and methods for allocating the Scholarship, qualifications of eligible applicants, the amount of scholarships to be allocated, and the expenses of the Scholarship; and issue these details as announcements of the University.

(3) Appoint sub-committees to consider and determine how to allocate the Scholarship, in accordance with the criteria determined by the Committee.

(4) Perform other duties assigned by the University Council.”

Article 5 – All Committees that existed before the effective date of this Regulation shall continue to perform their duties until the appointment of the Committee described under this Regulation is completed.
