**Thammasat University Regulation, re:
The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University
Scholarships for Graduate Students, B.E. 2564**

Where it is deemed appropriate to create the Thammasat University Regulation, regarding the Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students, a subject that has been reviewed and approved by the resolution of the Finance Committee, by virtue of Article 52 of the Thammasat University Regulation, re: Financial, Budget, and Accounting Management, B.E. 2564, from the 3/2564 Meeting, which took place on August 20th, 2021.

By virtue of Section 23 (2) and (4) of the Thammasat University Act, B.E. 2558, and by the resolution of the University Council from the 9/2564 Meeting, which took place on August 30th, 2021, it has been agreed to issue the aforementioned regulation, as follows.

Article 1 – This Regulation is called “*Thammasat University Regulation, re: The Establishment and Administration of the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students, B.E. 2564*”

Article 2 – This Regulation shall come into force from the day after the announcement date onwards.

Article 3 – In this Regulation

“*University*” means Thammasat University.

“*Faculty*” means faculties, colleges, and institutions responsible for providing education.

“*Scholarship*” means the Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students.

“*Committee*” means the Management Committee of Scholarships for Graduate Students.

“*Students*” means graduate students of the university.

Article 4 – The Rector shall maintain compliance with this Regulation and shall have the power to issue any announcements or orders of the university, as well as to interpret and make a final decision regarding this regulation, in order to ensure compliance with this Regulation.

Section 1
Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students

Article 5 – The University shall establish a scholarship, called the “Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students”, to serve the following objectives.

(1) To create theses, dissertations, and independent studies that can be published in academic journals or academic publications, or can be presented to the academic conference and afterward published in the conference proceedings.

(2) To support graduate students, as the Committee deems appropriate.

Article 6 – Incomes and assets of the Scholarship are, as follows.

- (1) Annual incomes allocated from the University, for an amount equal to ten percent of the credit fees collected by the ordinary graduate programs of the Faculty.
- (2) Budget allocated from the University, for an amount equal to five percent of the social service project fees, specifically the education service program (for the graduation ceremony), as well as service fees collected by internal agencies that provide educational services.
- (3) Funds and assets that are donated to the Scholarship.
- (4) Return on investment and profits of the Scholarship.
- (5) Other gains or benefits.

Article 7 – Expenses of the Scholarship are, as follows.

- (1) Scholarships provided under Articles 5 (1) and (2).
- (2) Other necessary administrative expenses.

Article 8 – The Committee shall consist of the Vice-Rector assigned by the Rector to serve as the Chairman, as well as at most 10 other directors appointed by the Rector.

The Section Chief assigned with the duty and responsibility over the Scholarships for Graduate Students shall serve as a director and secretary of the Committee, and at most two other assistant secretaries shall be appointed.

Article 9 – The Committee shall have the authority and duty to manage the Scholarship as per objectives described under Article 5, as follows.

- (1) Consider and determine the criteria for allocating the Scholarship provided under Article 5.
- (2) Consider and determine the amount and payment details of the Scholarship provided under Article 5.
- (3) Prepare and present the performance report of the Scholarship to the University Council once a year.
- (4) Prepare and present recommendations regarding the amendments and improvements of this Regulation or related procedures to the Rector.
- (5) Perform other duties assigned by the Rector or the University Council.

Section 2 **Asset Management and Audit Control**

Article 10 – The Treasury Division shall be responsible for receiving, disbursing, and managing assets of the Scholarship, as well as accurately preparing and reporting the financial statements.

Article 11 – The Internal Audit Office shall be responsible for auditing the financial statements and reporting the audit result to the Rector and the University Council, respectively. The audit process must be completed within the timeframe specified in the Thammasat University Regulation, re: Financial, Budget, and Accounting Management.

Article 12 – In the event that this Regulation does not specify provisions for specific issues, the provisions of the Thammasat University Regulation, re: Financial, Budget, and Accounting Management shall apply mutatis mutandis.

Transitional Provisions

Article 13 – All Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students established under the Thammasat University Rule, re: Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students, B.E. 2554, and the amendments thereof; the Thammasat University Rule, re: Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students (No. 2), B.E. 2555; and the Thammasat University Rule, re: Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students (No. 3), B.E. 2558, shall now be classified as Scholarships under this Regulation.

Article 14 – All Committees that existed before the effective date of this Regulation shall continue to perform their duties while observing this Regulation until a committee has been appointed in accordance with this Regulation.

Article 15 – All operations currently conducted while observing the Thammasat University Rule, re: Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students, B.E. 2554, and the amendments thereof; the Thammasat University Rule, re: Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students (No. 2), B.E. 2555; and the Thammasat University Rule, re: Thammasat University Scholarships for Graduate Students (No. 3), B.E. 2558, before the effective date of this Regulation shall continue to follow those Rules until completed.
