**Thammasat University Announcement, re:  
International Academic Conference Promotion Grants, B.E. 2564**

---

WHEREAS, Thammasat University has the policy to promote and improve the quality of research for academic excellence, and for such a purpose, the University establishes the International Academic Conference Promotion Grants, aiming to promote and support the university workers to produce and publish research of high quality at the international level.

By virtue of Section 39 of the Thammasat University Act, B.E. 2558, and Article 16, Paragraph Two of the Thammasat University Regulations, re: Research and Research Fund Management, B.E. 2561, and by resolution of the Research and Research Fund Management Board from the 2/2564 Meeting, which took place on September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the Rector hereby issues the following Announcement.

**Article 1** – This Announcement is called “*Thammasat University Announcement, re: International Academic Conference Promotion Grants, B.E. 2564.*”

**Article 2** – This Announcement shall come into force from the day after the announcement date onwards.

**Article 3** – This Announcement shall repeal and replace “Thammasat University Announcement, re: Criteria and Methods for Granting the International Academic Conference Promotion Grants, B.E. 2563.”

**Article 4** – In this Announcement.

“*The Board*” means the Research and Research Fund Management Board.

“*The Grants*” means the International Academic Conference Promotion Grants.

“*The Sections*” means the faculties, colleges, or institutes.

“*International Academic Journals*” means academic journals listed on the international databases, such as SJR (SCImago Journal Ranking: [www.scimagojr.com](http://www.scimagojr.com)), ISI Web of Science (Science Citation Index Expanded, Social Sciences Citation Index, Art and Humanities Citation Index), or the Scopus Database.

**Article 5** – The International Academic Conference Promotion Grants provide co-funding to the Sections that organize international academic conferences and, therefore, provide platforms for university workers to exchange knowledge and experiences in research, as well as improve the collaborative working environment and research networks, with other external organizations, both domestically and internationally.

**Article 6** – In order to request the International Academic Conference Promotion Grants described under Article 5, the conference must possess the following qualifications.

(1) The conference must be approved by the Section-level committee.

(2) The organizing committee of the conference must be an International Advisory Committee or an International Scientific Committee that consists of foreign professors, experts with doctoral degrees, or experts whose works are widely accepted in their fields of study from more than 2 countries. In addition, these foreign professors and experts must account for no less than 25 percent of the members of the organizing committee.

(3) Foreign organizations outside the University from several countries, such as institutes, professional associations, or internationally recognized organizations, must co-organize or participate in the conference.

(4) The conference must produce proceedings that will be published in international academic journals, whether in the form of an electronic copy or hard copy. These proceedings must also be evaluated by experts in the related fields.

(5) It must be clearly demonstrated that the underlying subjects of the conference produce impacts internationally, and the results of the conference will produce beneficial impacts on society.

(6) Foreign participants of the conference must account for no less than 20 percent of all participants.

(7) Lecturers or students of Thammasat University must present their academic works or research results to the conference, whereas no less than ten articles must be published in the proceedings described under Item (4).

**Article 7** – The Grants will be paid in a lump sum, for an amount of 200,000 Baht in total. The payment will be made in two installments, as follows.

(1) The 1<sup>st</sup> installment will be paid after the application for the grant has been approved, for an amount of 140,000 Baht.

(2) The 2<sup>nd</sup> installment will be paid after the Research Administration Division receives the proceedings that have been published in international academic journals, for an amount of 60,000 Baht.

**Article 8** – The Grant Application process will be subjected to the following criteria and methods.

The Section that wishes to apply for the Grant must verify that the conference possesses the required qualifications described under Article 6 and then submit the request to the Research Administration Division. The request must include the following documents.

(1) The Application Form for the International Academic Conference Promotion Grants.

(2) Supporting documents showing that the conference possesses the required qualifications described under Article 6.

**Article 9** – After the conference under Article 6 has ended, in order to request the payment of the 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of the Grant, the Section must submit the proceedings published in the international academic journals to the Research Administration Division.

**Article 10** –The interpretation of this Announcement is within the authority of the Vice Rector for Research Administration.
